1번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 만들 가방을 고르시오.

M: Hannah, what are you doing?

W: Dad, I'm making a shoulder bag out of my old jeans.

M: It looks great. Reusing old jeans is good for the environment.

W: Thanks. I'm going to add a pocket to make it more useful. But, I think it needs a final touch.
