1번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 만든 카드를 고르시오.

M: Hey, Jenny. What is that?

W: It's a thank-you card I made for my parents.

M: Wow! It's good! I love the heart shape.

W: Thanks! I drew the carnation myself. What do you think?

M: It's beautiful. Why don't you add 'thank you' over the flower as well?

W: I don't know. That might be too much. The flower seems to be enough.

M: You're right. I'm sure they'll love it.

2번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 여자에게 전화한 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Hello, this is Lee's dental clinic. How can I help you?

M: Hello, my name is John Smith. I have an appointment at 3 in the afternoon today.

W: What time do you want?

M: How about 10 a.m. tomorrow?

W: Um. Sorry. Dr. Lee has a meeting at that time. How about 2 p.m.?

M: That's fine. I'll be there tomorrow afternoon.

W: Yeah. I'm glad it's not that serious, and I'd love to visit her.

M: Great. Why don't we meet at Hills Bakery at 4?

W: You mean the one next to the post office, right? I'll meet you there.

M: All right. See you there.

8번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 여자에게 부탁한 일로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Hello, Mr. Han. Did you want to see me?

M: Yes. Sports Day is around the corner. How's it going?

W: We got our group T-shirts yesterday. Also, we're almost done with cheering practice.

M: Good. Can you make a list of participants for each game?

W: I can. I'll make sure that every student plays in at least one game.

M: Great. Thank you.

10번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 지불할 금액을 고르시오.

M: Excuse me. How much is it to make copies of a calendar with photos?
