1번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 만든 북마크를 고르시오.

M: Emily, there's a bookmark on your desk. Did you make it?

W: Yes, Dad. It's a birthday present for Rachel.

M: Good job! This bookmark looks like a star. It looks nice.

W: Thanks. I wanted to make it in a heart shape, but Rachel really likes stars.

M: I see. You drew just a smile. Why didn't you write any words on it?
