1번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 구입할 목 베개를 고르시오.

W: Hello. How may I help you?

M: Hi, I'd like to buy a neck pillow for my daughter.

W: How about this one with flowers on it?

M: It's okay, but these animal-shaped pillows look better.

W: Okay. The rabbit, the panda, and the pig are popular among kids.

M: I see. She likes pigs the most. I'll take the pig-shaped one.
