ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번 다음을 듣고, 광주와 날씨로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: You're listening to *Good Morning Korea*. Let's check today's weather report. Seoul began the morning with light raindrops, but it'll stop raining in the afternoon. Daejeon will be foggy, so you should be careful when you drive. Gwangju will be very hot under strong sunshine, so be sure to wear your sunglasses. In Busan, strong winds are expected. Thank you.

2번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 만든 강아지 집으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Minsu, what's this? Is this house for your puppy?

M: Yes, I made it for my puppy, Max.

W: Wow, it looks great! Oh, there's even a window!

M: Yes, I did. I think Max will like it.

W: Then, go to Section A. It is for those jobs.

M: What about doctors and nurses?

W: Oh, the medical jobs are in Section C.

M: Thank you. Where are those sections?

W: Here's a map of this place. You can check the details.

M: All right. It'll help me a lot.

6번 대화를 듣고, 여자의 마지막 말의 의도로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Jack, why are you so late?

M: I'm sorry, Mom. I just finished my club's practice.

W: Oh, right! You said you were going to have a school dance performance.

M: Yeah, it's not easy, but we're doing our best.

W: Great! I'm looking forward to seeing you dance.

M: Thanks, Mom. I just hope we won't make any mistakes.

W: Good luck with your performance.

7번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 선택한 보고서 주제를 고르시오.

M: Grace, what are you going to write about for your science report?

W: I'm looking up some information about water.

M: Isn't that too simple?

W: Not at all. I think it can be very interesting. What about you?

M: I chose clouds as my report topic.

W: Clouds? Why did you choose that topic?

M: I think clouds are amazing, so I read many books about them.

8번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 대화 직후에 할 일로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: What are you doing, Amy?

W: I'm making invitation cards for our school festival.

M: Can I see? *[Pause]* Why is it empty here?

W: I want to put our school map there, but I'm not good at drawing.
