ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 구입할 자전거를 고르시오.

M: Hello, may I help you?

W: Hi. I'm looking for a bicycle for my seven-year-old son.

M: Okay. Would you like a bicycle with or without a basket?

W: Um... I guess a bicycle with a basket would be more convenient.

M: Alright. Then, you can choose one from these. We have ones with stripes and without them. They are all popular.

W: They all look nice, but the striped one would be better.

M: Good choice! Now, do you need one with training wheels in the back?

W: Yes. He just started learning how to ride a bicycle. So, I'll take the one with training wheels.

M: Okay. I hope your son likes this bicycle.
